Supplementary information regarding participation in sports challenges available on the MyBenefit Website linked to Google Fit

- 1. The User may use the MyBenefit Service in its full functionality that allows them to participate in sports challenges and which consists, among other things, of displaying on the Service information about their physical activity, in particular:
 - a) the type of the activity (e.g. walking, running or cycling),
 - b) activity data (number of calories burned or number of steps taken),
 - c) data on other workouts added to Google Fit by other applications,
 - d) distance travelled,
 - e) the speed at which The User is moving.
- 2. In the case referred to above, the User's data will be obtained from entities that offer additional services in connection with the User's account on the Website. This means that the source of the User's data will be an additional service, including in particular the Google Fit service, whose provider is Google Ireland Limited.
- 3. The data listed in point 1 above is processed in order to enable the User to participate in the sports challenges to which they join by themselves. The data will not be used for other purposes, in particular, to assess the User's health condition.
- 4. The User's personal data may be transferred to the following entities: Benefit Systems Group entities, entities providing hosting and maintenance services for websites and applications, entities providing ICT and IT support and security services, entities providing storage and destruction services for data carriers, entities offering additional services, legal advisors and entities conducting audits.
- 5. The User has rights concerning the processing of their personal data: the right to request access to personal data; the right to request rectification of personal data; the right to request deletion of personal data; the right to request restriction of personal data processing, the right to object to the processing of personal data; the right to personal data portability; the right to withdraw consent to the processing of personal data; and the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection.
